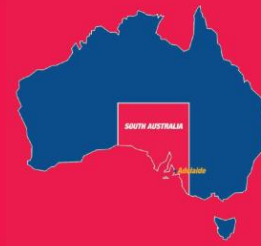

Dependants

South Australian Government Schools



All school aged dependants must be enrolled at school as per visa conditions



1. Primary School

- Enrolments from age 5 at local primary school
- 8 year period from Reception to Year 7



2. Secondary School

- Enrolments from age 12-13 at local secondary school
- 5 year period form Year 8 to Year 12

Finding a School

- Determined by the suburb where family lives
- Dependants are entitled to enrol at their local, zoned school

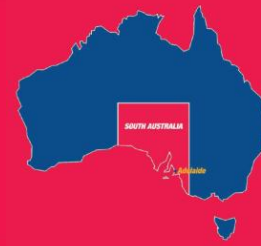

Fees for Dependants

Fees for dependants will be determined by visa subclass and if parent has scholarship approved by Australian or South Australian government

Fee Variations

1. **Dependant International Fees (Award Courses only)**
 - Primary School: \$3600 per child/year
 - Secondary School: \$4500 per child/year
 - Application and Administration Fee: \$500 per family
 - Annual Administration Fee: \$300 per child
 - Materials and Services Charges, direct to school

2. **Parents Hold Approved Scholarship**
 - No tuition fees or administration fees
 - Materials and Services Charges, direct to school

Full International Fees

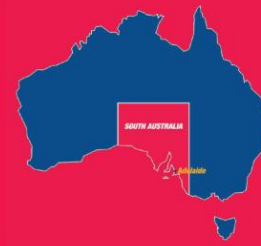

- Primary School Tuition: \$8000 per child/year
- Secondary School Tuition: \$9500-\$10500 per child/year
- Other fees apply

Fees on Letter of Offer must be paid BEFORE commencement at school.

Process for Children eligible for Dependant International Fees

- Submit to International Education Services (IES)
 - Application Form (Dependants of International Students)
 - Parent's COEs
- IES issues Letter of Offer
- Payment of fees required
- IES issues Letter of Confirmation
- Parent makes appointment for enrolment at school
- Dependant Notification of School Form returned to IES

New Arrivals Program (NAP)

Specialist NAP Centres available to support children with limited English

- All dependent fee paying children are eligible to enrol
- Your local primary/secondary school will refer you to the closest NAP centre

Advantages of NAP

- 30 hours/week of English language development
- regular bilingual support
- regularly measure English language development
- learn about Australian schools and community
- develop their confidence to live in the Australian community
- small classes (15 – 18)
- Teachers understand new arrivals
